ACHIEVEMENTS

While going through our plan at the end of year, we found that we achieved a lot which was quite satisfactory

1. Academic aspects & new courses

- 1.1 We started remedial coaching course for the students who had been failed in English, Accountancy, statistics in march 2009-10 Exams organised by Shivaji University Kolhapur and provided coaching to the students in B.Com I for the subjects English and Accountancy. At the same time we provided coaching to the students in B.Com II & B.A.II for the subjects stat, Accountancy & English respectively. Special preferences were given to the students in S.C &S.T. Categories.
- 1.2 We have started B.C.A. three year degree course in the academic year 2008-09. This year we started B.C.A.III with the help of well qualified staff and full hedged computer lab we have been running the Course successfully.

- 4.5 Two of our faculty members have submitted their minor research projects proposals to U.G.C. to get sanctioned. Some of our faculty members have contributed in the process of University's efforts to bring innovations in curricular design and transactions by participating in it.
- 4.6 Many of our faculty members presented their research papers in national/International/State/university level Seminars while some of our



faculty members published their research articles/creative writings in reputed journals, magazines and newspapers.

4.7 Our faculty members implemented new courses effectively.

5. Extension Activities:-

Various committees of the college were entrusted with different extension activities. Academic and non-academic programs were undertaken continuously during the year.

- 5.1 Vocational course of 'Personal Beauty Care' at certificate level has been started for girl's students in collaboration with ITI Islampur.
- 5.2 Tree plantation programme was undertaken in nearby village, kasegaon by N.S.S. Dept to participate in 'Echo Village' campaign initiated by rural Development minister.
- 5.3 Survey of kasegaon on 'Death Rate and Reasons' has been completed under National Rural Health campaign.
- 5.4 Blood donation camp was conducted in co-operation with Rajarambapu Blood Bank, Islampur.
- 5.5 N.S.S. volunteers participated in 'Alert Citizens' campaign initiated by S.P. sangli.
- 5.6 Many of the N.S.S. volunteers participated in various N.S.S. training camps and other activities to develop their various skills & personality development Skills.
- 5.7 Various activities were conducted through Marathi & English literary Associations to give impetus to latent qualities among the students i.e. 'Shabda-gandha' wall-paper, minor projects, screening of films, plays etc. which created interest among students about Marathi & English language and literature.
- 5.8 Our faculty members visited the villages in vicinity to meet parents and Students to create awareness about higher education and to motivate them to higher education. Teachers also visited parents to congratulate their words on bright performance in studies/sports to create healthy relation between



parents and teachers and for better performance of the excellence among students.

- 5.9 Lectures of experts were conducted on various topics throughout the year.
- 5.10 Significant days and festivals were celebrated to create awareness about historical events, patriotism & culture.
- 5.11 Counseling Cell conducted meetings of the students to provide guidance & counseling to the students on several issues i.e. suicides of students, Fears & tensions, one-sided love affairs etc.
- 5.12 Due to motivation students have started to refer latest journals, reference books & internet for getting more & updated information about the subject/topic.
- 5.13 Police Pre-Recruitment Training camp was conducted for the students willing to join police department by Gymkhana Dept.
- 5.14 Special coaching was provided to the talented and skilled sports persons by organizing special camps & through daily practice. College as well as teachers individually provided incentives to bright sports persons in the form of cash prizes, mementoes & special sports uniforms.

6. Students Welfare Activities:-

- 6.1 Physical and mental efficiencies were developed and sportsman spirit was created among the sport persons by counseling. Sports kits and other essential material were provided to the sports persons. Special coaching camp was conducted to provide coaching to skilled sports persons.
- 6.2 Handicapped sports persons were located and encouraged to participate even in national sports competitions. The efforts proved fruitful. one of our sportspersons handicapped Suryaji Sathe achieved first rank in fencing Competition organized by Maharashtra fencing Association and was selected for All india Handicapped fencing competition, held at Banglore.

6.6 Information was provided to the students about various scholarships at university, state & national level for merit and for reserved categories through standing committee of the college.

7. Community Services:-

Through N.S.S, Gymkhana Dept, Sexual Harassment prevention Committee community services based programmes were carried out in the villages in vicinity and as well as in college campus.

ACTIVITIES REFLECTING GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTION

1.1 A centre for overall development of students from rural area.

To create awareness about higher education among the students and their parents, we approached them regularly. After the result of XIIth board examination we visited the students and parents of remote villages in vicinity to induce them to take admission in our college. Pamphlets regarding information about various courses run by our college were distributed. We also took special efforts to create awareness about higher education especially among girl students by visiting organizations of women parents. We visit students to congratulate them for bright performances in sports as well as in University exams. We always take each & every possible effort to make our college a centre for overall development of students from rural area.

1.2 To offer our students every possible source of information.

We provided all possible sources of information like News Papers, National & International journals, periodicals, CD's, Cassetts, audio-visual aids, It is a thing worthy to mention that we provided facility of internet with INFLIBNET.

We also provided the information to students about several scholarships and Govt. schemes for concession in fees to motivate economically backward students. At the same time we provide the information regarding zonal, interzonal, state, national & regional level sports.



1.3 To seek permission for new courses in emerging area

To provide opportunities of careers we have already started 'Certificate Course in Tax Practice' a career oriented courses(U.G.C.) To improve communication skills of students in rural area we have been running 'Certificate Course in Communicative English'.

1.4 To evoke excellent and noble characters

We started remedial coaching courses for the students of B.A.I, B.Com.I,B.A.II & B.ComII in the subjects English, statistics & Accountancy. Special preference was given to the students in S.C., S.T. categories. The course proved fruitful.

We conducted various competitions such as essay competition, elocution, poetry reading, sports competition for personality development of students. We also conducted 'special coaching' for Sports persons for better performances. Besides, we motivated our students to participate in various competitions organized by other colleges, Institutions, Universities, GOs & NGOs etc.

For personality development of students we organized various lectures of eminent persons. Our teachers provide guidance for competitive exams.

1.5 To imbibe social values among students

We conducted several activities to imbibe social values among Students through lectures conducted by N.S.S. & other departments. We encouraged students to participate in 'Echo village' campaign at Kasegaon and 'Alert Citizens' campaign at kasegaon. Rallies Were organized to create awareness about Health, public cleanliness, Open defecation free village, dire consequences of female feticide, gender equality, women empowerment etc. our students contributed their Services for making a survey of kasegaon village for 'Toll Rate and it's Reasons' cleaning college campus, tree-plantation etc. Our N.S.S. Volunteers participated in 'Dear Daughter Campaign' a district level Workshop organized at Atpadi. The participation of our N.S.S. volunteers in 'Youth-meet' under the guidance of Hon'ble Shree, Ravishankarjee is also Worth to mention. Such activities created



social commitment among the students and helped to evoke them to become good citizens and noble characters.

5. Examinations Reforms implemented:

As per university guidelines examination pattern for B.A.III & B.Com III has been reformed and 80:20 pattern has been accepted. According to this pattern, terminal exam of 40 marks and oral test of 10 marks were conducted for B.A.III & B.Com III, and the marks were converted into 20 marks according to University guidelines.



At the same, the nature of B.A.I & B.Com I exams has been reformed. According to university guidelines we implemented semester system for these classes, where written exam of 40 marks and oral test of 10 marks were conducted for each semester. Besides, a fine was charged for the candidates failing to appear for Terminal Exam and a re-exam was conducted for such students.

In addition to this, department wise seminars, Group Discussions were conducted for the students. Projects were assigned for the students of environmental Science. There is good co-ordination between exam committee and teachers which helped to conduct exams successfully. as a part of syllabus, we organized Bank-Visit, Industrial Visit & study tours for the students.
